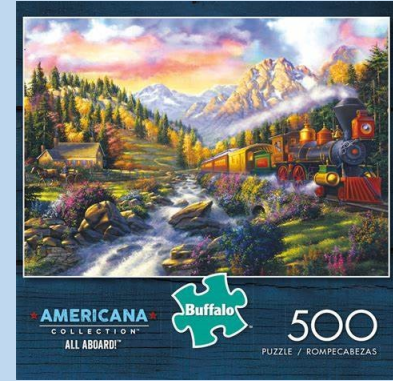
Many bars in the United States, and abroad, serve green beer to celebrate St. Patty's Day.
