

Judith Conrad Sagrera was born on August 8, 1935, to Allen and Estelle Conrad, a well-known family recognized for owning the Conrad Rice Mill. She graduated from Mount Carmel College in New Iberia and went on to study Biology and Biochemistry at Louisiana State University, earning her Bachelor of Science degree. While at LSU, Judith was honored to serve as the editor of the 1958 LSU yearbook and was actively involved in several academic societies. Following her undergraduate studies, she pursued Medical Laboratory Technology at Charity Hospital in New Orleans under LSU's guidance. She then returned to New Iberia, working for a year at the original Iberia General Hospital on Main Street. That same year, she married Dr. George Sagrera. The couple moved to New Orleans, where Dr. Sagrera completed a hospital internship from 1959 to 1960. After the internship, Dr. Sagrera joined the U.S. Navy, and the couple relocated to San Francisco for two years. During that time, they welcomed their first child, Sarah—marking the beginning of Judith's cherished role as a devoted homemaker and mother. After returning to Cajun Country, Judith and George expanded their family with three more daughters: Adrianna, Camille, and Andre. Known for her fiery spirit, which she often attributed to her German roots, Judith approached motherhood with passion and resilience. As a homemaker, she cultivated lifelong friendships and became widely known for her exceptional cooking, eye for home décor, and event planning. In her later years, Judith remained active—enjoying tennis, bridge games with friends, and horseback riding. For the past eight years, she has been a resident of Garden View, where her spirited personality continues to shine. She still enjoys a good meal, anything chocolate, and, most of all, the company of her beloved family and friends.
