Betty Beeson Helms was born in 1940 in Fitzhugh, Arkansas, to Woodrow and Geneva (Masters) Beeson. Her parents were farmers who worked the fertile White River bottoms in White and Woodruff Counties. Betty grew up alongside her three sisters—Frances, Lee, and Bonnie—spending her early years chopping cotton, driving tractors, and helping with the daily work on the family farm. In 1958, she graduated as valedictorian of her class at Bradford High School in Bradford, Arkansas. Shortly after graduation, she married Charles Helms, and the couple moved to California, where Charles served in the U.S. Navy and Betty began working for various government agencies. Betty and Charles welcomed their first son, Charles (Chad) Helms, Jr., in 1970, followed by their second son, Travis Helms, in 1972. Betty is the proud grandmother of nine grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren, and she cherishes the time she spends with them. Over the course of her career, Betty worked for both the Internal Revenue Service and the Social Security Administration, dedicating

over 35 years to public service before retiring in 2007. After the passing of her father, she took on the role of General Partner of Beeson Farms, continuing her family's legacy. Following her divorce in 1974, Betty raised her two sons as a single mother—an accomplishment she holds with great pride. In addition to raising her own children, she also hosted three exchange students—Roland, Peter, and Betty—and formed close, lasting bonds with them and their families. Betty has a wide range of interests and hobbies, including sewing, quilting, music, and traveling. A highlight of her travels came in 2013, when she and her sister Bonnie visited France and the Bordeaux region, staying at a vineyard chateau where she had the opportunity to meet a distant cousin. A lifelong woman of faith, Betty has been active in church since childhood. She was formerly a member of Bradford Baptist Church in Bradford, Arkansas, and later the First United Methodist Church in New Iberia. Today, Betty is enjoying life in her new home at Garden View, where she especially appreciates the friendships she's made, participating in bingo, and staying active with her exercise group. Still proudly independent, she continues to drive and rarely misses an opportunity to attend her grandchildren's school events and sporting activities.
