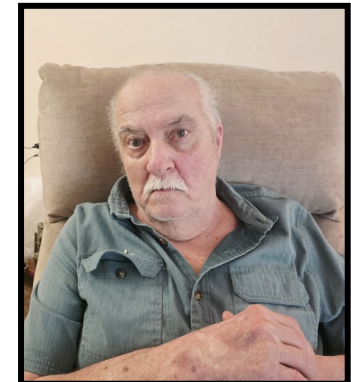
Resident of the Month
